Elgie, the little grey cat with a come back!

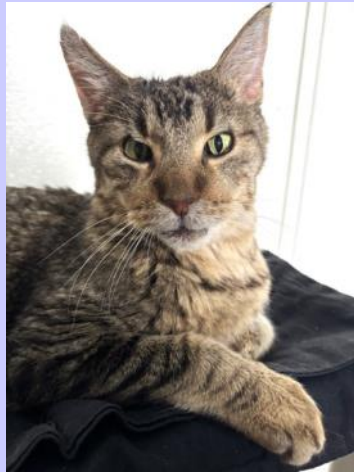

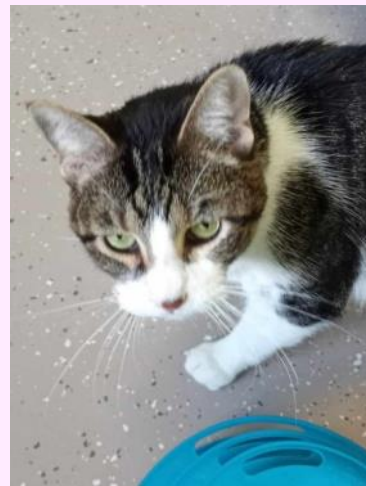
with lots of room to run and play.

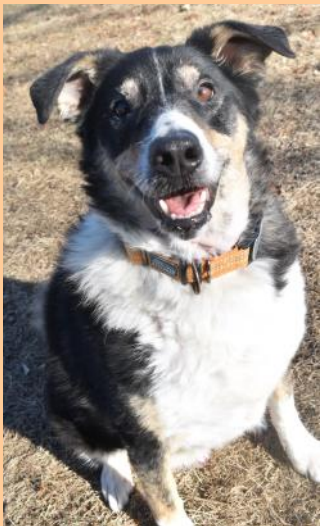
