HSWC Statistics

HSWC is an Adoption Guarantee Facility. That means that all healthy animals that can be safely placed in homes are put up for adoption and kept up for adoption until a home is found, or until circumstances change. It happens once in a while that an animal we thought was adoptable turns out to be no longer acceptable for adoption due to new-found health concern, or a behavior come to the surface that we were unaware of. We take out commitment to these animals and our community very seriously, and try to do what is best for the animal first while also considering what's also best for the community. Some animals are adopted quickly, other are with us for months and months—but we keep looking for a great home for each and every one of our “adoptables.”

Pawesome Four assist Humane Society (article from Waupaca County Post)

The Waupaca Middle School

Destination Imagination team held a supply drive for the Humane Society of Waupaca County.

The team of eighth-grade girls came up with a plan to motivate students to bring supplies.

The “Pawesome Four” decided to hold a competition between homerooms at WMS and Waupaca Learning Center.

Whoever collected the most supplies would win “puppy time.”

After getting approval from school administration, the girls got to work figuring out details and a timeline. They used the list on the Humane Society’s website as a guide for asking for specific donations.

The Waupaca Area Miracle Tree let them borrow the boxes (donated by Gusmer Enterprises) they will use this Christmas, for their collection boxes in the classrooms. And the Humane Society offered to lend them some puppies for the “puppy time” reward.

The supply drive took place from Nov. 6-16. It didn’t take long before reports of overflowing boxes started coming in, so the team ended up doing multiple collections before Nov. 16.

They collected more than 2,000 items, ranging from paper towels and cleaning supplies to more 900 pounds of pet food, as well as \$394.

Winning classrooms include: 4K – Frosch (75 items), kindergarten – Kennedy (74), first grade – Blonde (66), second grade – Riggle (104), third grade – Parent (116), fourth grade – Williams (118), fifth grade – Phair (70), sixth grade – Waitrovich (50), seventh grade – Binning (39), eighth grade – Wilson (37). Each class was able to spend about 15 minutes with Great Dane puppies, Madison and Moose.

As part of their Destination Imagination project, the team tallied every item collected and will use that data in their presentation at the Regional Tournament in February 2018.

The category the Pawesome Four will be competing in, Project Outreach, empowers youth to make an impact on their communities by working together to help meet a community need.

The Vet happened to be at HSWC on the day he arrived, so he had an exam and was neutered right away. We could tell he was a sweet, happy dog and were excited to start looking for his new home.

Fate must have been watching out for him, because within just a few days of arrival, it became apparent to kennel staff that something was very wrong.

He was taken to the Vet Clinic immediately, where initial tests and exams indicated exploratory surgery was in order. Of course we OK'd the surgery- he was too nice of a dog to give up on without trying to save him.

It turned out he had a condition called "intussusception", a serious condition of the intestines, which they were able to surgically repair and give him a good prognosis. If he hadn't had the surgery, he would have almost certainly died within a few days.

Within a few days, he was back to his usual goofy, energetic self. Several weeks before this newsletter went to print, he was adopted....and THAT makes all the trouble and expense worth every penny. (Continue on next page)

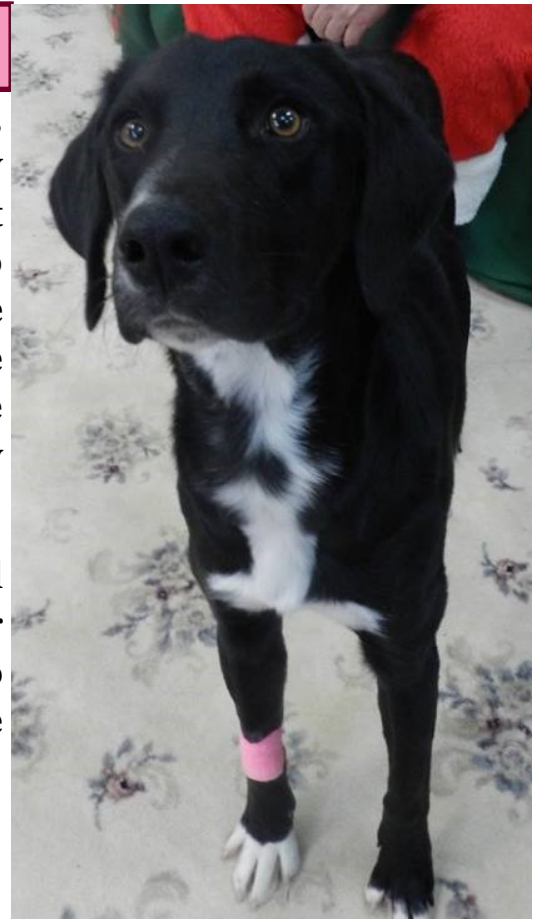
Petie continued

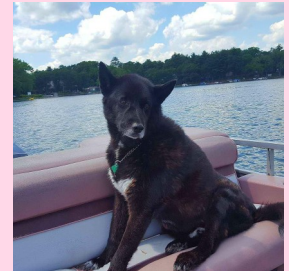

Since you're going to mail in a Valentine anyway, why not take another moment to ask us something you've always wanted to know on the form below? We will pick the most popular subjects and answer a few letters in the next Paw Prints! Why don't we start in this issue by answering the most commonly asked question:

"Is this a No Kill Shelter?"

The answer, from Monica Gardner, the Operations Manager of the HSWC Adoption Center:

"I don't like using that terminology because it implies that there IS such a thing as a Kill Shelter and that is a contradiction of terms. If you are simply killing animals, you can't also be a shelter. We do sometimes euthanize animals. Euthanize means to give a good/kind/gentle death, and that is sometimes necessary in cases of extreme injury, chronic painful conditions, terminal illness and true, dangerous aggression. Our euthanasia rate is less than 5%, which is VERY conservative. Furthermore, we try to use our resources, when available, to assist other shelters that are not able to maintain rates that low, in the hopes that some day, we can all meet that goal."

Who's your Daddy?

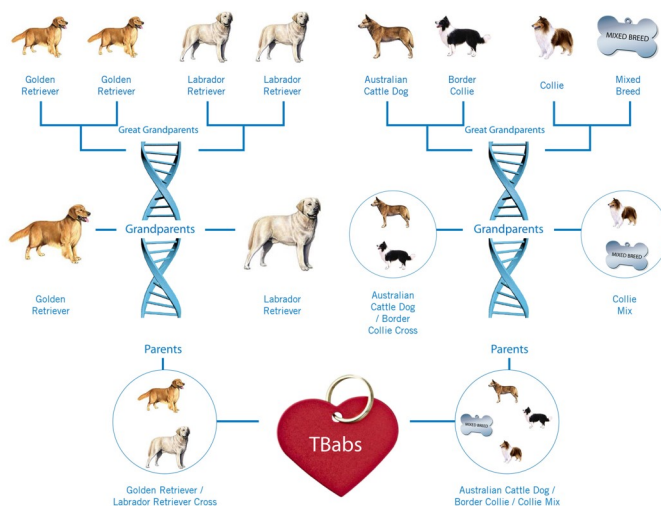
Thanks to the Belisle Fund of the St. Croix Valley Foundation Grants, we've been able to DNA test many of our residents over the past few years! The results have allowed us to create individual enrichment plans for dogs with higher energy levels and know any possible health concerns. For instance, Collies and other herding breeds can be sensitive to certain commonly used medications. Puppy TBabs is a great example! She looks like a Golden Retriever or Labrador, but with the results of Dog Trax, we now know she's also mixed with Collie, Border Collie and Australian Cattle Dog, all of which are sensitive to Ivermectin, commonly used for parasites like heart worm.

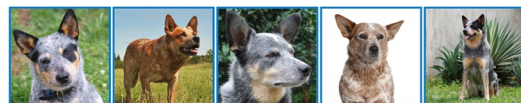
