Expanding our Services

In response to observed increasing need in our area, we are offering the following services to our community:

Paws In Need

Emergency pet supplies such as food an litter are usually available to support pet-owning families with short term needs to help them care for their pet during times of hardship Please call ahead so we can have it ready for you.

Lower cost spay/neuter services are available by appointment. Vaccinations and other routine wellness—services can also be provided at time of surgery. If your pet is already altered and simply needs vaccinations, microchip or a blood test, please come to one of our drive thru clinics.



No More Litters

This is a special program for qualified low income families, subsidized by our generous donors, for spay/neuter services. Cost is \$20 per cat and \$50 per dog. Vaccines, microchip and/or blood test can be provided at time of surgery for an additional fee.

Drive Through Vaccination+ Clinics

We will be offering these periodically. Vaccinations, microchips and Heartworm tests can be performed. This is a Wellness Clinic. Please make an appointment with your veterinarian if your animal is sick or injured.






