It feels like Groundhog's Day to be typing another article about this, because it has been "in planning" for so long! The graphic illustrates some of the actual plans in the works!

Due to higher-than-anticipated estimates for the clinic building project, we had to make some major changes to our plans, but we are trying not to let that further delay construction.

We anticipate signing a contract for the project in September 2023, and will still likely have a groundbreaking this fall! Hopefully this will be accomplished by the time you are reading this.

HSWC has savings designated to cover much of this project, but funds will still be needed to pay off the construction company, install kennels and medical equipment and furnish the building. Once completed, this building will serve as a vital resource for Waupaca,

surrounding communities, and many other shelters and rescues in central Wisconsin. We will be able to greatly increase the number of spays/neuters done monthly, as well as increase our offering of vaccination and microchip clinics.

As of this writing, we still need to sell about 15 Memorial Bricks so we can place the order we have been working on for a few years now. You can find the order form on the back of this page. All proceeds from the Brick Sales will go to the building fund. I can't wait to show you the photos of our groundbreaking!
