

# Welcome to the Family



I had a nice little bittersweet cry tonight as I was editing this newsletter.

There are several memorials in this issue for dogs I personally rescued from overcrowded shelters, took them into my own home and eventually found them homes. As evidenced by the memorials, they were well loved and I know they had great lives and made their families very happy. After HSWC installed the dog kennels and started receiving dogs, I closed down my rescue, transferred my last 2 dogs over and focused all my efforts at HSWC.

The owners of some of those dogs I rescued have since returned to adopt and brought family members to adopt. In fact, many previous HSWC adopters come back to us when they're ready to add another family member, referring their friends and family to us as well. They follow our facebook page, call us for advice and send us Christmas cards and photos, which we are absolutely delighted to receive!

Over the past few years, we have noticed many people returning to us to adopt a pet because their first experience with us was such a positive one. While it's always difficult hearing about the loss of their beloved pet, it's also exciting to know we'll be sending another lucky animal home to live with a fantastic family!

My staff and I have been told over and over how gifted we are at making good matches, and that's why people come back. When you adopt from HSWC, you're not just buying an animal like in a pet store. You're joining our family! How involved with us you choose to be is up to you- but we want you to know we're here if you need help with training, travelling with your pet, introducing new family members, etc... And when the time comes that you have to make difficult decisions near the end, we're here for you and we understand.

**For us, it's not about how many we find homes for or how fast. It's about how WELL we do it.**

There is a disturbing trend in the shelter business to focus on what I call "Sheltering by the Numbers". The phrase, "Length of Stay" gets a lot of use. That means the number of days an animal stays at the shelter until it is adopted, euthanized, transferred or dies. "Average Length of Stay" reflects how long all the animals you're sheltering have been with you. It could be all animals in the building, or all animals housed in the last 6 months- the report can be fully customized.

I believe all shelters should continuously strive to reduce Length of Stay numbers, I also feel it is irresponsible for us to do that in a manner that may put pets in danger. One obvious, but unspoken way of reducing an animal's Length of Stay is to euthanize it. Off the top of my head, I'll estimate that 10% of adult dogs and cats that find themselves in a shelter have a really hard time adjusting the first few days. Depending on where they have been admitted, this could put them in grave danger. They are fearful and panicked and may lash out at caretakers and a quick conclusion may be reached that they are unadoptable. We have found that a few days and some patience and good treats can go a long way for most of these animals. At HSWC, unless they are truly vicious and dangerous to staff, these animals all get a minimum 2 week plus Length of Stay. Following this policy increases our Average Length of Stay- but we are all about quality over quantity. That is why, during our adoption process, we will be trying to get to know you and your family so we can make the best matches, not just quick ones!

We prefer to focus on our Live Release Rate, which is, the percentage of animals that leave a shelter alive through adoption or transfer. We have explained that in a previous issue, but if you'd like to understand it better, feel free to call me!. Meanwhile, here are the statistics for our last fiscal year, April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018.


2 years ago (on March 9<sup>th</sup>) we adopted a puppy from you. He was named Cash at the time but was renamed Boomer when we took him home.



# Anyone can catch your eye...

## Chester & Twiggy

Chester and Twiggy came to my home in October of 2017 at about 6 weeks old. They were malnourished and weak, due to mom developing Mastitis and being unable to properly nurse them. They , along with a sibling, who has been adopted already, were hand fed with a syringe every two hours, until they were



strong enough to eat on their own. Chester developed just fine, but Twiggy began to show signs of bowel/stomach issues. After many months of supplements, schedule and diet adjustments, her system does very well on a mix of Purina Hairball Dry and Royal Canin Calm Dry. Since the Royal Canin costs a bit more than regular brands, we have just started to switch her to a different Purina recipe and will see how she does. As you can see,



Chester and Twiggy are bonded, they sleep together, play together and groom each other. We want them to find a home where they can stay together, so we do not add any further stress to Twiggy's system.

They have been around other cats, birds, dogs (small and large), and young children. Twiggy, a typical Torbie - at times prefers to play independently - stalking and carrying around her toys, but does love her belly rubbed and to snuggle up with you in fuzzy blankets! Chester is your all around easy going guy...lets the toddler pull his tail and ears, loves attention, and will rub your face with his nose to let you know he loves you. As with all my past fosters, it is very hard to let them go...but once I know they have found their furrever family, then I can open my home up to someone else who is needing some extra TLC. All of us HSWC employees have opened up our hearts and families to special needs fur kids. Some other shelters may not have the option to do that, having to choose to euthanize instead. We will continue to bring these babies (and in some cases adults) into our homes, to give them the special around the clock attention they deserve, and get them on their feet and ready for their next adventure!! 




## **Primrose**

## **Gilbert**



She will be an eager and willing student.





# Pets Rock Road Tour



Pet's Rock Road Tour is one of HSWC's community outreach programs, lead by a group of our wonderful and dedicated volunteers! Pet's Rock is mobile and compatible with a variety of locations. The volunteers, along with one or more adoptable animals from the shelter, travel in an effort to provide more people with the opportunity to meet and interact with shelter animals, to advocate for animal welfare, to distribute information, to educate the community and much more!

Having this outreach program has been a success in many ways. It has provided HSWC an opportunity to create recognition for our organization by allowing us to be present, active and involved out in the community. The transportable aspect of Pet's Rock makes it possible for us to affect many people that we may otherwise have been unable to reach. It has made it possible for us to collect donations and funds for our shelter. Our volunteers try to be as informed as possible, so they are able to answer questions and help pet owners in many ways. Though adoptions are not able to be finalized at the Road Tour events, adoption applications are always on hand and can be completed there, without the need to make an extra trip to our adoption center to do so. We are also provided with a further ability to promote and advocate not only for our shelter, but all of the animals in our care. This greatly increases their chance of a timely adoptions into loving forever homes.



Another great aspect of Pet's Rock is that it gives our organization the ability to positively impact the lives of others and to give back to the community in some unique and creative ways! We are able to make special visits to places where we can make a big difference to those in need! Schools, nursing and retirement homes all benefit! It's truly heartwarming to see how uplifting a visit from an animal can be to the students or residents. You can see the genuine happiness it brings and the smiles on their faces. Just to be able to witness, let alone actually help to make such experiences possible... is deeply moving and something that cannot be explained in words! Just petting an animal can be extremely therapeutic. They are able to provide therapeutic emotional support. They possess a love that's so pure and unconditional. The opportunity to have that interaction, can make a huge impact and a world of difference for some people as well as being beneficial to our residents.

Pet's Rock attends numerous community events in Waupaca County & the surrounding areas. Some of the events we have attended: Strawberry Fest, The Health Fair, Wautopia-Arts on the Square, Fall-O-Rama, Fire Fest, Scandinavia Corn Roast, Autumn Festival and The Home Show. We go to many local businesses such as several Family Video locations and Culvers, as well as libraries, schools, grocery stores, shopping centers, nurseries and gardening centers such as Turner's Fresh Market and Silver Mist.
